



2024 Corinthian Friday Night Races

April 5 to August 30, 2024

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The racing will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. One Design class rules will be in effect where a One Design class is declared in the Sailing Instructions
- 1.4. Power assisted winches are permitted if disclosed and included in a boats PHRF rating. This modifies RRS 52.
- 1.5. Nothing in these rules relieves any participant from their duty to comply with health requirements

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at: <https://race.cyc.org/FNR2024>
- 2.2. One entry per boat will be accepted.
- 2.3. Entries must be received by 2359hrs March 31, 2024
- 2.4. Entries submitted after March 31 may be permitted at the discretion of the race organizer.
- 2.5. Entry is open to all monohull boats with a valid 2024 NCPHRF rating certificate. The race committee may, at its discretion, waive the ratings certificate and/or, assign ratings to boats provisionally or finally where (a) YRA has not delivered an applied-for rating or (b) racing one-design or (c) racing non-spinnaker.
- 2.6. Fleets will be defined based on entry registration
 - **PHRF fleets** will be grouped primarily based on their relevant assigned rating.
 - **One Design fleets** may be formed when five or more entries of that class are registered and will subject to their respective One Design class rules. One Design classes with sufficient entrants to form a fleet, may have a separate start.

- **Non-Spinnaker Fleet** is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, if accepted by the Race Committee. Boats listed on the NCPHRF Base Rating Report as **No NonSpin** are not eligible to register in the Non-Spinnaker fleet. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification by the Race Committees at its discretion.

3. FEES

3.1. The entry fee for the entire regatta (both 1st and 2nd Half series) will be \$220 for each boat.

3.2. The entry fee for a single race will be \$40 for each boat.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1. The race schedule is separated into two series.

4.2. Each series will consist of one race each Friday, conditions permitting, with the first warning signal scheduled at 1815hrs.

4.3. FNR First Half will include races from April 12 to June 14, 2024.

4.4. FNR Second Half will include races from June 21 to August 23, 2024.

4.5. The races on April 5 and August 30 will be Pursuit format races.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the first race.

6. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

7.1. FNR First Half and FNR Second Half series included races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF and one design Class Rules with each series being scored separately under the low point scoring system of appendix A amended such that boats scored DNF, RET, TLE or NSC will be scored one more point than boats scored as finishing. Boats scored DNS, DSQ or OCS will receive one more point than the number of boats starting that race in its fleet, and boats scored DNC will receive two more points than the number boats starting that race in its fleet in that race. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

7.2. Pursuit races on April 5 and August 30 will be scored using time-on-distance and will not be scored as part of any series.

7.3. Boats entering one or more single races will not be scored as part of the series. This modifies RRS A2.2.

7.4. The time limit for each race will be 15 minutes after sunset for San Francisco.

7.5. FNR First Half and FNR Second Half will be scored separately. There will be two score throw outs in each series.

7.6. One race will constitute a series.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may make radio transmissions to communicate information to competitors using VHF1066 (66A).

9. PRIZES

9.1. Daily and series trophies may be awarded.

9.2. Daily prizes will be presented at the CYC Clubhouse following each day's racing. A boat representative must be present to collect daily prizes.

9.3. Series trophies will be presented at the CYC Club House following the completion of each series.

9.4. A notice will be posted if changes to health or other regulations limit or prohibit the ability to present trophies in person.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance.
