

# LXXII Corinthian Midwinters Series

## January 20-21 & February 17-18 2024



## Notice of Race

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. One Design class rules are in effect where there is a One Design fleet formed.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at:  
<https://race.cyc.org/mids24>
- 2.2. Only one entry per boat will be accepted.
- 2.3. All participating boats should have a valid 2023 or 2024 NCPHRF certificate. The race committee may, at its discretion, waive the ratings certificate and/or, assign ratings to boats provisionally or finally where (a) YRA has not delivered an applied-for rating or (b) racing one-design or (c) racing non-spinnaker.
- 2.4. Fleets will be defined based on entry registration and may include PHRF, Non-Spinnaker, One Design, and Sportboat. A fleet with five or fewer boats may be merged with another fleet. Final fleet assignments will be set out in the sailing instructions;
  - **PHRF fleets** will be grouped primarily based on their relevant assigned rating and hull characteristics.
  - **One Design fleets** may be formed when five or more entries of that class are registered.
  - **Non-Spinnaker Fleet** is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, if accepted by the Race Committee. Boats listed on the *NCPHRF Base Rating Report* as **No NonSpin** are not eligible to register in the Non-Spinnaker fleet. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification by the Race Committees at its discretion.



### **3. FEES**

- 3.1. The entry fee for the entire regatta will be \$215 for each boat which includes one (1) post race buffet dinner for both January 20 and February 17.
- 3.2. Entries must be received before January 14, 2024
- 3.3. Entries submitted after January 14, 2024 may be permitted at the discretion of the race organizer.

### **4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

- 4.1. Four races are scheduled in the regatta, with one race each day. January 20-21 and February 17-18, 2024.
- 4.2. First Warning Signal is scheduled at 1230hrs on all race days.

### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than January 15, 2024 by 18:00hrs on the web site at: <https://race.cyc.org/mids24>

### **6. VENUE & COURSES**

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

### **7. PENALTY SYSTEM**

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply and will be included in the SI's.

### **8. SCORING**

- 8.1. Handicapped divisions will be scored time-on-time.
- 8.2. One race must be completed to constitute a series. There will be no throw-outs.
- 8.3. The time limit for each race will be 16:45 hrs. Boats failing to finish before the time limit expires will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes *RRS* 35,A4 and A5.

### **9. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

The Race Committee may make radio transmissions to communicate information about the start and recalls.

## **10.PRIZES**

- 10.1. Daily and series trophies will be awarded.
- 10.2. Daily prizes will be presented at the CYC Clubhouse following each day's racing
- 10.3. Series trophies will be presented at the CYC Club House following the event.

## **11.INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance.
