



2021 Corinthian Friday Night Races

April 9 to September 3, 2021

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. One Design class rules are in effect where sufficient boats are registered to form a One Design fleet.
- 1.4. Short-handed Fleet(s) only - Autopilot and/or wind powered self-steering equipment, and power assisted winches are permitted. This modifies RRS 52.
- 1.5. All boats must have adequate means of self-propulsion or sufficient ground tackle to be able to maintain a position against adverse tides and conditions.
- 1.6. All Boats are required to have a functioning VHF radio aboard at all times.
- 1.7. Nothing in these rules shall be construed to relieve any participant from their duty to comply with Marin County health requirements.

2. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 2.1. The series will consist of one race each Friday, conditions permitting, with the first warning signal scheduled at 18:15 hours (6:15pm).
- 2.2. The Spring Series will include races from April 9 to June 11.
- 2.3. The Summer Series will include races from June 18 to August 27.
- 2.4. The race on September 3 will not be scored as part of the series.
- 2.5. A minimum of three races will constitute a series.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at:

- 3.2. One entry per boat will be accepted.
- 3.3. All participating boats should have a valid 2021 BAMA or NCPHRF certificate. The race committee may, at its discretion, waive the ratings certificate and/or, assign ratings to boats provisionally or finally where (a) YRA has not delivered an applied-for rating or (b) racing one-design or (c) racing non-spinnaker.
- 3.4. Fleets will be defined based on entry registration and may include Multi-hull, PHRF, J/105, AE28, J/24, J/70, J/88, Non-Spinnaker, One Design Short-handed and Sportboat.

- **One Design fleets** are formed when five or more entries of that class are registered and will have a separate start.
- **Short-handed Fleet** entrants will be accepted for those racing single or double handed. This will be a spinnaker fleet only.
- **Non-Spinnaker Fleet** is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and specified other boats, if accepted by the Race Committee. IOD's, Wyliecats and other cat boats shall race in the Spinnaker division. AE28s shall race in the AE28 division. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification by the Race Committees discretion. Knarr's registered in a Non-Spinnaker fleet will have their rating adjusted.

4. FEES

- 4.1. The entry fee for the entire regatta will be \$145 for each boat.
- 4.2. The entry fee for a single race will be \$35 for each boat.
- 4.3. Entries must be received before April 7, 2021
- 4.4. Entries submitted after April 7, 2021 may be permitted at the discretion of the race organizer.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the first race.

6. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF and one design Class Rules with each series being scored separately under the low point scoring system of appendix A amended such that boats scored DNF, RET, DNS, DSQ or OCS will receive one more point than the number of starters in that race, and boats scored DNC will receive two more points than the number of starters in that race.
- 8.2. Boats entering a single race will not be scored as part of the series. This modifies *RRS* A2.2.

8.3. The time limit for each race will be 15 minutes after sunset for San Francisco. Boats failing to finish before the time limit expires will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

8.4. The Spring and Summer Series will be scored separately. In each Series, when fewer than seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. In each Series, when seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

9. PROTESTS

Protest hearings may be held by a video or other conference forum at a time agreed by the protest participants.

10. PRIZES

Daily and series trophies may be awarded and will be available at the CYC Office following the event.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance.
