



Inaugural Corinthian Mid-Summer Races

July 13-14 & August 10-11, 2024

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. One Design class rules are in effect where there is a One Design fleet formed.
- 1.4. All boats must have adequate means of self-propulsion or sufficient ground tackle to be able to maintain a position against adverse tides and conditions.
- 1.5. Nothing in these rules shall be construed to relieve any participant from their duty to comply with health requirements

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Entry is open to Monohull boats. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at: <https://race.cyc.org/summer24>
- 2.2. Only one entry per boat will be accepted.
- 2.3. All participating boats should have a valid 2024 NCPHRF certificate. The race committee may, at its discretion, waive the ratings certificate and/or, assign ratings to boats provisionally or finally where (a) YRA has not delivered an applied-for rating or (b) racing one-design or (c) racing non-spinnaker.
- 2.4. Fleets will be defined based on entry registration and may include Multi-hull, PHRF, One Design and Non-Spinnaker. A fleet with five or fewer boats may be merged with another fleet. Final fleet assignments will be set out in the sailing instructions
 - **PHRF fleets** will be grouped primarily based on their relevant assigned rating and hull characteristics.
 - **One Design fleets** may be formed when five or more entries of that class are registered and will be subject to their respective One Design class rules. One Design fleets may have a separate start.
 - **Non-Spinnaker Fleet** is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and specified other boats, if accepted by the Race Committee. Boats designated as “no non-spin” in the NCPHRF Base Rating Report (<http://yra.org/ratings/>) shall race in spinnaker fleets. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions may be subject to ratings modification by the Race Committees discretion.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee for the entire regatta will be \$200 for each boat
- 3.2. Entries must be received before July, 11 2024
- 3.3. Entries submitted after July 11, 2024 may be permitted at the discretion of the Race Organizer.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. The Race Committee intention is to have two races on July 13 and August 10 and one race on July 14 and August 11.
- 4.2. The first warning signal is scheduled at 1230hrs on all race days.
- 4.3. For days with multiple races, the second start will follow the finishing of the first race.
- 4.4. Races will not be started after 1530hrs.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply and will be included in the SI's.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Handicapped divisions will be scored time-on-time using the NCPHRF rating.
- 8.2. One race must be completed to constitute a series. No scores will be excluded.
- 8.3. All racing will conclude by 1800hrs. Boats failing to finish before the time will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes *RRS* 35,A4 and A5.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may make radio transmissions to communicate information about the start and recalls.

10.PRIZES

Series trophies will be presented at the CYC Clubhouse following the event.

11.INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance.
