

Corinthian Yacht Club Folkboat/Knarr Regatta

May 16-17, 2026

Notice of Race



1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. The local fleet rules for each of the one design classes apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Entry is open to SF Bay Knarr Association and SF Bay Folkboat Association members
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at the event website <https://race.cyc.org/fkr26> and paying the entry fee.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee for the regatta will be \$125 for each boat before May 12, 2026 and \$175 thereafter.
- 3.2. Entries must be received by May 15, 2026

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. The committee intends to run up to three races per day, but may vary that number as conditions merit. The Knarr class is intended to have three races Saturday and two races Sunday.
- 4.2. First Warning Signal is scheduled at 1230hrs.

5. COMMUNICATION

- 5.1. The online official notice board is located at the event website.
- 5.2. All boats shall carry a VHF radio.
- 5.3. On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 5.4. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the start of the first race on the web site at: <https://race.cyc.org/fkr26>

7. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place in central San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply and will be included in the SI's.

9. SCORING

There will be a 15 minute finishing window in each race. Boats failing to finish before the finishing window time limit expires will be scored TLE without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5. No races will be started with a first warning signal after 3:30 pm Saturday and 3:00 pm Sunday.

10. PRIZES

Event awards will be presented at a celebration at the CYC Clubhouse following the regatta.

11.INSURANCE

Each participating boat must be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
