Double-Handed / One Design
Sailing Instructions
Sunday, August 30, 2020
Organizing Authority: Corinthian Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. Local class rules shall also apply with the exception to those class rules relating to crew composition or weight. J/105 Class Rules 3, 7.5 and 7.9 are waived for this regatta.
- 1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment." Code flag "Y" will not be displayed.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix V1 and V2 will apply.
- 1.4 Autopilot and/or wind powered self-steering equipment is permitted. This modifies RRS 52.
- 1.5 Nothing in these rules shall be construed to relieve any participant from their duty to comply with health requirements.
- 1.6 A boat shall be crewed by two people who
 - 1.6.1 are in a single household or social bubble and shall fly a yellow flag from the backstay no smaller than 12" x 14" or
 - 1.6.2 remain masked at all times and shall make reasonable efforts to maintain a physical distance from one another.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1 All boats must display on their mainsail the sail number shown on their entry form or gain Race Committee (RC) approval for a change by 10:00hrs on the day of the race.
- 2.2 Only one entry per boat will be accepted.
- 2.3 All boats must check in before starting by hailing the race committee by stating Boat Name, Sail number and "We confirm SPP Compliance" on VHF 72. Check in will be available from 11:00hrs to 11:50hrs. A boat not confirming SPP compliance and has not received acknowledgement by the race committee will be scored DNC.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the CYC website at <https://race.cyc.org/pan>
- 3.2 Written changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted by 08:00hrs on the day of the race, except that written changes to the schedule of the races will be posted by 20:00hrs on the day before it will take effect. The CYC website may have copies of such documents.
- 3.3 Oral changes to the Sailing Instructions may be made on the water. If the race committee intends to provide oral changes, it shall display the "L" flag and attempt to hail competitors on VHF channel 72.
- 3.4 All references to the CYC Notice Board in the Sailing Instructions shall be deemed to read the CYC Website <https://race.cyc.org/pan>

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 One race is planned for the regatta.
- 4.2 The scheduled warning signal for the first race is 12:00hrs.

6 RACING AREA, COURSES, MARKS AND RESTRICTED AREAS: (courses and marks described in Addendum A)

- 6.1 The racing area will be San Francisco Bay and its entrances.
- 6.2 Numeral placards displayed on the Committee Boat will indicate courses.
- 6.3 All boats are required to avoid designated restricted areas detailed
 - 6.3.1 Richmond Long Wharf and a line connecting buoy R "2CR" FI R 4s marking Castro Rocks
 - 6.3.2 Buoy R "2" Q R (approx. 0.4 nm WSW of the Wharf), buoy G "3" FI G 4s (approx. 0.3 nm S of the Wharf) and the Richmond shore northeast of G "3".
 - 6.3.3 A line between Anita Rock and its buoy "AR" (located NW of Anita Rock).
 - 6.3.4 Each of the lines bounded by the points below and the closest points ashore:
 - Anita Rock
 - Buoy "AR" (located NW of Anita Rock).
 - The "H" Beam (located approximately 200 yards W of StFYC)
 - The Bell Buoy off the W end of Alcatraz Island
 - The buoy S of Point Blunt on Angel Island
 - The South tower of the Golden Gate Bridge
 - Buoy R "2CR" FI R 4s marking Castro Rocks - and the Richmond shore

7. **STARTING LINE** – The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the CYC Committee Boat and a temporary buoy in the vicinity ~ 0.5nm WNW of Point Knox.

8. **FINISHING LINE** – The finishing line will be between an orange banner on the CYC Race Deck and a temporary buoy.

9. **TIME LIMIT** - The time limit for the race will be 18:00hrs. Boats failing to finish before the time limit expires and after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

10. **PROTESTS** - Protests shall be delivered electronically to the CYC Club Regatta Chair at racing@cyc.org by 10:00hrs on Monday August 31. A list of protests received will be posted on the Club website. Protest hearings may be held by a video or other conference forum at a time agreed to by the protest participants.

11. **RETIRING BEFORE FINISH** – A boat that retires prior to finishing shall notify the race committee on VHF 72 or by phone as soon as reasonably possible.

12. **TROPHIES** – Trophies will be awarded to the highest placed mixed gender team and to the highest placed boat in each fleet. A boat representative must collect their trophy when trophies become available at the CYC office during normal club administration operating hours.

13. **INTERFERENCE WITH OTHER VESSELS**

13.1 Boats shall not impede the passage of a vessel that can safely navigate only within a narrow channel, fairway or large-vessel traffic lane. Boats so doing shall be subject to protest and disqualification upon notice from any competitor, the RC, a government agency, or the operator of the vessel.

13.2 A boat that receives five or more horn blasts from a commercial or government vessel shall be presumed to have impeded such passage. The time for protest will be extended in such cases. This changes RRS 61.3.

14 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** – Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
